Faculty, Staff, and Parents

The faculty and staff of J.K. Hileman Elementary believes that parental involvement in the educational activities of the school is essential to a student's success or failure in his/her academic endeavors. In keeping with the core belief held by parents and teachers at J.K. Hileman Elementary, the following parental involvement policy has been set forth:

- ◆ The J.K. Hileman Elementary faculty will provide frequent reports to parents on their children's progress. J.K. Hileman will conduct beginning of the year and end of the year parent teacher conferences. Phone conferences will be made as needed.
- ◆ Progress Reports are sent home every 3rd and 6th weeks during a nine-week period. Report cards are sent home at the end of each nine-week period. Teachers will send individual reports from their classes as needed. Teachers shall be available to discuss student progress with parents as needed.
