

J.K. Hileman Elementary School shall require students in grades K – 4 to participate in moderate or vigorous daily physical activity for at least 30 minutes throughout the school year, as part of the campus physical education program. If the campus determines that requiring moderate or vigorous daily physical activity is impractical due to scheduling concerns or other factors, the campus may as an alternative require a student to participate in moderate or vigorous physical activity for at least 135 minutes during each school week. The campus will provide an exemption for a student who is unable to participate in the required physical activity because of illness or disability.

Morris Upchurch Middle School shall require students in grade five to participate in moderate or vigorous daily physical activity for at least 30 minutes throughout the school year, as part of the campus physical education program and shall require students enrolled in grade level six, seven, and eight to participate in moderate or vigorous daily physical activity for at least 30 minutes for at least four semesters during those grade levels as part of the campus physical education program. If the campus determines that requiring moderate or vigorous daily physical activity is impractical due to scheduling concerns or other factors, the campus may as an alternative require a student to participate in moderate or vigorous physical activity for at least 135 minutes during each school week. The campus will provide an exemption for a student who is unable to participate in the required physical activity because of illness or disability.
